# Resetting an Account

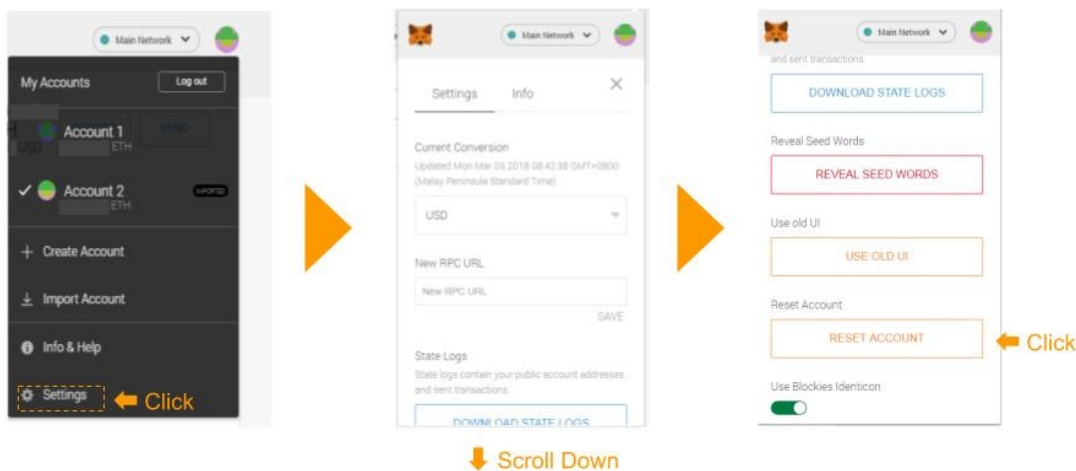

## Curiosity doesn't kill the fox. It empowers it!

To reset the account:

1. Open the "My Account" page by clicking the icon on the upper right corner, and select "Settings"
2. On the "Setting" page, scroll down to find "Reset Account".
3. Click "Reset Account"



Note that this process is irreversible, and not a common feature for most users.

Developers, however, may find it useful to reset a test network while continue using the same account. By doing so, MetaMask deems the network ID a clean network in a fresh state.
